



## THE VENETIAN BAD BEAT GIVEAWAY PROMOTION RULES

1. The Bad Beat Giveaway Promotion is for all contributing Texas Hold 'em Poker Games.
2. Participating games include \$1-\$3 and \$2-\$3 No Limit Hold 'em games and \$4-\$8 and \$8-\$16 Limit Hold'em games that are not a part of a Bomb Pot hand or Mix game and does not have a time collection for rake.
3. Beginning January 1 through December 31, 2026("Designated Dates"), The Venetian Poker Room will award the player with a qualifying Bad Beat hand in any participating game a Bad Beat Giveaway prize of \$2,000 and all players at the table dealt into the bad beat hand ("Table Share") a Bad Beat Giveaway prize valued at \$200 each ("Giveaway").
4. To qualify for the Bad Beat Giveaway, a player must have a qualifying hand of Quad Deuces or better beaten by a better hand. Both hole cards must play in any qualifying Quads or better hand. Pocket pairs are required for any winning or losing hands of Quads or better. Both hole cards must play for any winning or losing Straight or Royal Flushes. Only the losing hand is qualified and eligible for the Bad Beat Giveaway \$2,000 cash prize.
5. On the first of every month, if the Bad Beat Giveaway was not awarded in the previous month, the Bad Beat Giveaway prize will be increased by \$1,000 for the losing hand and increased by \$100 for all other players dealt into the Bad Beat qualifying hand. This increase will continue for all subsequent months until the Bad Beat Giveaway prize is awarded. At that time, the Bad Beat Giveaway prize will be reset to \$2,000 for the losing hand and \$200 for all players dealt into the Bad Beat Giveaway qualifying hand. If the Bad Beat Giveaway prize was awarded before the 15th day of any given month and then not awarded for the remainder of the month, the Bad Beat Giveaway prize will increase on the 1st day of the following month. For any Bad Beat Giveaway prizes awarded after the 15th day of any given month, the Bad Beat Giveaway prize will remain as is on the 1st day of the following month.
6. Winner is permitted to add any portion of the Giveaway to their current chip stack. Once one (1) hand is played after Winners receive their Giveaway, standard table stakes rules apply.
7. A qualifying Bad Beat hand must be clearly tabled by both the winning and losing hands at the completion of all action.
8. It is the player's responsibility to alert the dealer of a qualifying Bad Beat hand. Any potential Bad Beat Hand that is not brought to the attention of the dealer or a supervisor within the next two hands of play, that was properly tabled, will result in that Bad Beat hand being null and void. The player who had the potentially losing Bad Beat Hand will forfeit any portion of the Bad Beat Giveaway in dispute.
9. Any player who is deemed by poker management to intentionally collude, conspire, or coach other players into playing their hand in order to potentially win a Bad Beat Giveaway cash prize, may have their potential Bad Beat hand disqualified, may be asked to leave the poker room for the day, and may have their playing privileges revoked altogether. These concerns should be brought forth by players and/or poker room dealer to poker management in real time so we can investigate, monitor, and resolve as needed to protect the integrity of the promotional pool.
10. There must be a minimum of four players dealt in at the beginning of the hand, in order to qualify for the Giveaway.
11. A qualifying hand can use any five card combination, provided they use both hole cards in their hand. Quads must be a pocket pair and a Straight Flush must utilize both hole cards. Both the winning and losing hands must be the best five card hand.
12. Giveaways will be paid from a promotional pool funded by The Venetian Promotional Progressive Pots and Pools, Drawings, and Giveaway Programs Rules ("Promotional Pool"). During the Bad Beat Giveaway, the Promotional Fund drop per hand will be \$1 on the flop, with a second \$1 taken if/when the pot reaches twenty (\$20) dollars total. 13. Bad Beat Giveaway participants must present a valid ID and a Venetian Rewards card to collect Giveaway. Giveaway will be forfeited if participant refuses to provide a valid ID and a Venetian Rewards card. Forfeited Giveaways will remain in the Promotional Pool.
14. If the Bad Beat Giveaway participant is willing but unable to produce a valid ID and a Venetian Rewards card, they will have seven (7) days to claim the Giveaway at the Poker Room Cage. Giveaway will be forfeited if participant does not provide a valid ID and Venetian Rewards card within 7 days. Forfeited Giveaways will remain in the Promotional Pool.
15. Participant is responsible for paying all taxes and fees in connection with claiming the Giveaway.
16. Giveaways are nontransferable.
17. The Bad Beat Giveaway is subject to The Venetian Poker Rewards Terms and Conditions and Venetian Rewards Terms and Conditions.
18. The Venetian Resort Las Vegas management is not responsible for any computer malfunctions.
